The goal of A New Direction (AND) is to provide rehabilitative services to female sex workers in order to help them transition out of the lifestyle.

In order to receive services on a voluntary basis through the AND program, women must have participated in prostitution and have an adult criminal conviction.

Walk-in services are available at OAR's Central Office location at One North Third Street. In-jail services are available through the OAR case manager at each jail.
