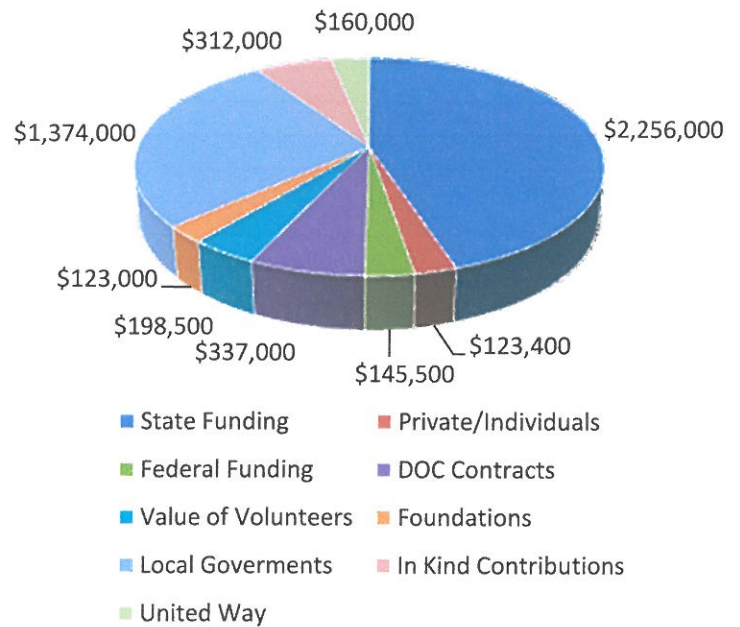


# PAPIS: Virginia Reentry Coalition - FY10

## Service Highlights

- ✓ 19,150 individual clients served
- ✓ 67 full time reentry staff
- ✓ 7,786 clients receiving job assistance, employment skills, job placements and job retention counseling and support contacts
- ✓ 1,246 full-time jobs obtained
- ✓ 1,742 clients receiving housing assistance service
- ✓ 2,461 clothing assistance service units provided
- ✓ 4,132 identification documents obtained for clients
- ✓ 14,245 transportation assistance service units provided
- ✓ 12,345 service units provided through clients' participation in educational and support groups – pre and post release
- ✓ 875 volunteers contributed over 15,500 hours of service

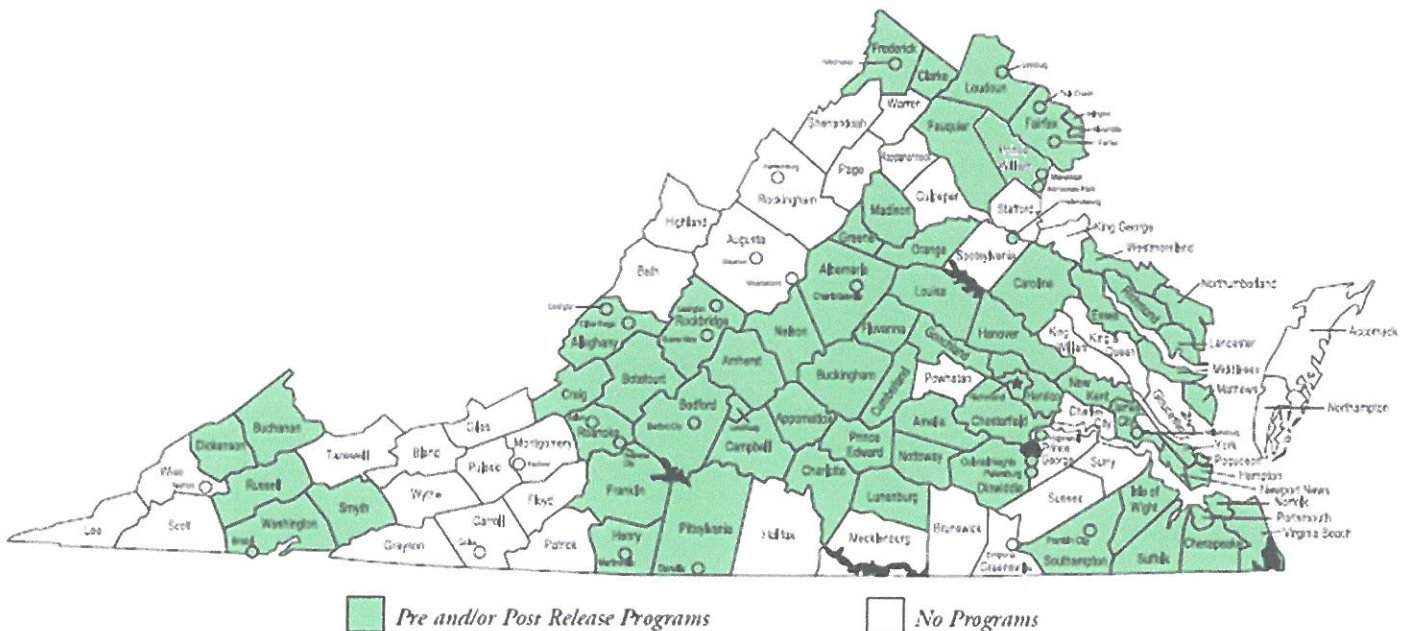
## PAPIS: FUNDING SOURCES



## Dollars and Sense

- ✓ 1,246 individuals secured employment, even in a terrible economic environment, generating an estimate of \$25.9 million in earned taxable revenue (based on just \$10 an hour).
- ✓ PAPIS members leveraged \$312,000 in in-kind Contributions, plus almost \$200,000 in volunteer time.
- ✓ PAPIS members generated \$1.20 (money, volunteer time and in-kind) for every \$1 the state contributed.
